ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Grade 12 or equivalent / Fluency in English
- Must be 18 year or older by the time you write your final SA-CAA examination
- Be an able-bodied person with excellent general health.
- Must be able to move unaided in water with a life jacket

TRAINING TIME

- 8 Weeks
- Mondays – Fridays 8am – 4pm

Intakes: Approximately every 12 weeks of the year (January to November)

This Ground Services course requires approximately 45 hours of study to be completed in 12 months from the purchase date (enrolment validity). After the enrolment validity expires, the users will not have access to the course content and will not be able to take the exam.
