#### **CABIN CREW AIR**

- Exam Method: Classroom exam at the SA-CAA
- Exam Format: Multiple Choice questions.
- No Textbooks are permitted
- Number of questions: 40
- Time Allowance: One hour
- Number of exam attempts: 2

#### **CABIN CREW SEA**

- Method: Written at SAMSA based in Durban
- Exam Format: Multiple Choice questions.
- No Textbooks are permitted
- Number of questions: 100
- · Time Allowance: One hour
- · Number of exam attempts: 2

#### **PASSENGER GROUND SERVICE**

- · Online exam with remote supervision
- You will be given 3 hours to complete 100 multiple choice questions (closed textbook)
- Passing grade is 60% correct answers, 90% correct answers are needed for a distinction
- You will be given 2 attempts to successfully complete the final exam
